THIS MATTER came before the Marine Employees' Commission for consideration of the Inlandboatmen's Union of the Pacific's Motion to Dismiss MEC Case No. 17-90.

On October 1, 1990, the Inlandboatmen's Union of the Pacific filed an unfair labor practice complaint against the Washington State Ferries. At the request of the IBU and WSF, a discussion of the complaint which was scheduled for October 30, 1990 (WAC 316-45-110) was postponed. By letter dated October 31, 1990, Larry Mitchell, Regional Director of the Inlandboatmen's Union of the Pacific, Puget Sound Region, withdrew the IBU's unfair labor practice complaint against WSF.

Pursuant to the withdrawal of the unfair labor practice complaint by the Inlandboatmen's Union of the Pacific (WAC 316-45-090), it is hereby ordered that MEC Case No. 17-90 is dismissed.
