

Please find under this letter a representation petition for Information Technology Professionals employed by the City of Seattle. Employees included in this petition are also currently included in petitions filed with PERC in Case 26658-E-14-3884, filed by the Professional Application Development Association (PADA), and Case 26660-E-14-3885, filed by the City Info Tech Professional Employees Association (CITPEA).

It is the position of both the petitioner (IBEW Local 77) in the attached petition and the petitioner (CITPEA) in Case 26660-E-14-3885 to withdraw the CITPEA petition in Case 26660-E-14-3885 and file this petition in its place. It is my understanding that CITPEA will be contacting your office shortly to complete the withdrawal process.

With regards to the bargaining unit configuration discussions that have been taking place in both the above cases, IBEW Local 77 concurs with the two answers given by CITPEA to the investigatory questions posed by PERC and IBEW Local 77 intends to participate in the November 12 meeting between the parties to discuss the bargaining unit configuration. Please also note that the attached petition includes Information Technology Professionals in two more departments than the CITPEA petition (Department of Planning and Development and Department of Neighborhoods.)

Per PERC regulations, copies of this petition have been served by email on PADA, CITPEA, and the City of Seattle and I duly swear to their service today. Hard copies are following to all the parties by US Mail.
