During the COVID-19 pandemic, arbitrator will conduct a prehearing conference with the parties two weeks prior to the hearing in order to assess the current level of restriction along with the parties' preferences as to the manner of hearing</li> </ul>
Constraints on Time:	None
Current Fees:	A per diem rate of \$1,600 is charged for hearing, research, and writing. A hearing day is any portion of a calendar day



	up to eight consecutive hours. If the day's hearing exceeds eight hours, an additional prorated charge shall be made at the per diem rate for the time period in excess of eight hours.
Cancellation Fees:	A cancellation of one per diem shall be charged for any case cancelled within two calendar weeks of the scheduled commencement of the arbitration hearing. No cancellation fee will ultimately be charged if the case is rescheduled for hearing within two calendar weeks.
Travel/Subsistence Charges:	Travel time in excess of two hours will be charged at ½ the per diem rate.
Other Fees Charged:	Actual costs of reasonable expenses including airfare, car rental, food and lodging will be charged. Automobile mileage is charged at the applicable IRS rate.
