ORDER CLOSING SETTLED GRIEVANCE

THIS MATTER came on regularly before the Marine Employees' Commission (MEC) on

December 20, 2006 when the Inlandboatmen's Union of the Pacific (IBU) filed a request for

grievance arbitration, docketed as MEC Case No. 11-07. The IBU's grievance alleged that

Washington State Ferries (WSF) failed to pay Charles Hargrett travel time and mileage in

compliance with the settlement in MEC Case 60-04.

Chairman John Swanson was assigned to act as Mediator for the settlement conference scheduled on March 5, 2007. Commissioner Elizabeth Ford was designated to act as Arbitrator and a hearing scheduled for April 6, 2007.

The IBU and WSF did not resolve the matter during the March 5 settlement conference. (The parties acknowledged that a pending Masters, Mates and Pilots' case, related to this issue, might also resolve Case 11-07.)

ORDER CLOSING SETTLED GRIEVANCE -1By telephone on April 5, counsel for WSF and IBU notified the Commission that the parties had reached a tentative agreement in the Hargrett grievance and requested that the April 6 hearing be cancelled. On April 17, 2007 the MEC received a copy of the signed settlement agreement, which constitutes withdrawal of the grievance. That agreement, as well as e-mail correspondence detailing when settlement payment is to occur, is appended to and becomes a part of this Order by reference.

#### ORDER

It is hereby ordered that the request for grievance arbitration, filed by the IBU and docketed as MEC Case No. 11-07, is closed in acknowledgement of the parties' settlement agreement.

# Settlement Agreement The Inlandboatmen's Union of the Pacific and The Washington State Ferries MEC Case No. 11-07

In order to provide uniformity concerning the payment of travel time and mileage to workers of the Inlandboatmen's Union of the Pacific and to resolve MEC Cases 11-07 involving a travel time and mileage grievance by Charles Hargrett, the parties enter into this Settlement Agreement.

## AGREEMENT

The parties agree as follows:

- 1. Charles Hargrett and other members of the Bremerton C watch shall be paid additional travel time of one-half hour and mileage of 26 miles for each day they had to travel to Bremerton. This represents additional travel through Southworth, the most reasonable mode of travel on the return to Seattle. This payment shall coveer the period from the date of the grievance onwards.
- 2. The IBU hereby withdraws MEC Case 11-07.
- 3. This agreement shall expire on June 30, 2009.
