THIS MATTER came before the Marine Employees' Commission for consideration of the Inlandboatmen's Union of the Pacific's motion to Dismiss MEC Case No. 13-90.

On September 17, 1990, the Inlandboatmen's Union of the Pacific filed an unfair labor practice complaint against the Washington State Ferries. A discussion of the complaint was held on September 28, 1990. WAC 316-45-110. The Commission later determined that the facts, if true and provable, may constitute an unfair labor practice. Commissioner Donald E. Kokjer was appointed hearing examiner. On October 4, 1990, the MEC served notice on the parties that a hearing was scheduled for November 16, 1990. On November 14, 1990, a continuance of the hearing was granted by the Hearing Examiner until December 6, 1990.

By letter dated December 4, 1990, Larry Mitchell, Regional Director of the Inlandboatmen's Union of the Pacific, Puget Sound Region, withdrew the IBU's unfair labor practice complaint against WSF.

Pursuant to the withdrawal of the unfair labor practice complaint by the Inlandboatmen's Union of the Pacific (WAC 316-45-090), it is hereby ordered that MEC Case No. 13-90 is dismissed.
