ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Pursuant to WAC 391-25-440, the petitioner Washington State Nurses Association seeks to add a group of five (5) previously unrepresented quality assurance and care transition Registered Nurses (clinical data abstractor, quality improvement specialist, quality assurance coordinator, clinical documentation specialist, and utilization review/clinical documentation coordinators) employed by the Employer to an existing appropriate bargaining unit of approximately 160 registered nurses, which WSNA already represents.

Accordingly, WSNA requests self-determination to add the petitioned-for previously unrepresented employees into the existing appropriate bargaining unit.

The existing bargaining unit, as described in Article 1, Section 1.1 of the most recent collective bargaining agreement, is follows:

All registered general duty nurses and resident nurses employed by the Hospital.

A copy of the most recent collective bargaining agreement is attached hereto.

With the addition of the petitioned-for employees, the resulting unit is appropriate for collective bargaining.
