Reasons for Clarification

A. Statement of Desire

Currently, the Pasco Commanding Officer's Association consists of all full-time and regular parttime Captains in the police department at the City of Pasco, excluding confidential employees, and all other employees. The City has created a new position, Lieutenants, and the Association seeks to add the Lieutenants to the Association.

The Pasco Commanding Officer's Association seeks to add the Lieutenants into the Association so the Captains and Lieutenants are in the same unit. The summary of the lieutenant position is to plan, organize, and supervise a section of the Police Department (Field Operations, Support Operations, and Professional Standards Division). An essential function of the Lieutenant position is to directly supervise designated portions of the Police Department as assigned. Another essential function is to assist division captain with the creation of division goals and objectives.

The summary of the police captain position is to plan, organize, and manage a law enforcement division of section of the Police Department (Support, Investigations, and Patrol). An essential function of the captain position is to manage field operations and support in the department to achieve goals within budgeted funds and available personnel.

Both Captains and Lieutenants have a position summary to supervise a section of the police department. As such, the Lieutenants have the greatest community of interest with the captains and they should be in the same unit together.



Subject: Case 137795-C-23 City of Pasco (Police Lieutenants)

On October 12, 2023, the Pasco Commanding Officers Association (union) filed a unit clarification petition concerning a bargaining unit of police captains working at the City of Pasco (employer). A copy of that petition is attached.

The union's current bargaining unit is currently described as:

All full-time and regular part-time Captains in the police department at the City of Pasco, excluding confidential employees, and all other employees

City of Pasco, Decision 13573 (PECB, 2022). The petition purportedly seeks to "amend" the bargaining unit certification under WAC 391-35-085 to add the Lieutenant classification. The ability for a union or employer to request modification of the bargaining unit description under WAC 391-35-085 is limited. The rule states:

A party may file a petition to amend an existing certification to reflect a minor change in circumstances, such as a change of an employee organization's name or an employer's name, and the executive director may amend the certification if the amendment does not add or remove positions from the existing bargaining unit or change the bargaining unit's configuration and there is no question concerning representation.

(emphasis added).

It is not clear from the filing that the outcome sought by the union can be granted because the petition lacks an explanation of its purpose

If the employer has changed the rank of the captains to lieutenant, then having the existing certification modified under WAC 391-35-085 would be appropriate because the change sought by the petition would simply reflect a minor change in circumstances, such as a change in job titles. If this is the case, the union should amend its petition and explain the minor change in circumstances and the reasons for amending the certification under WAC 391-35-085.

However, if the union seeks to add the lieutenant job class to the existing bargaining unit of captains, that change cannot be granted through the WAC 391-35-085 clarification process. As highlighted above, the amendment to certification process cannot add or remove positions from the bargaining unit. If the union is in fact seeking to add the lieutenant job class to its bargaining unit through the unit clarification process, the union should amend its petition to include a statement of the desire sought by its clarification petition and explain why clarification is appropriate under WAC 391-35-020.
